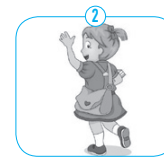

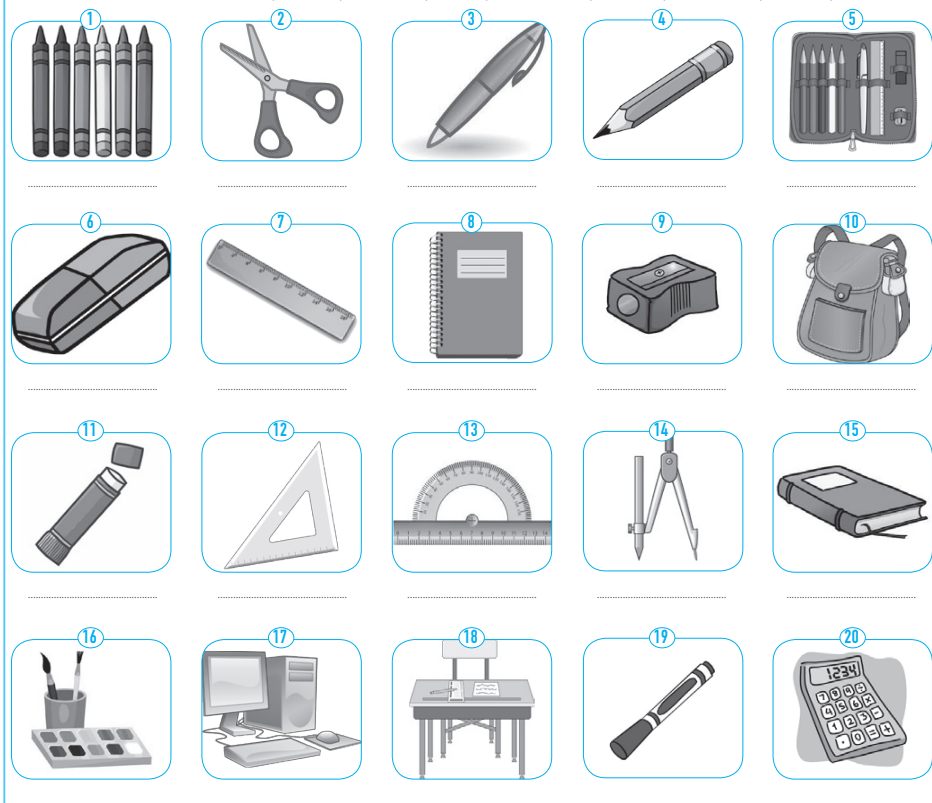

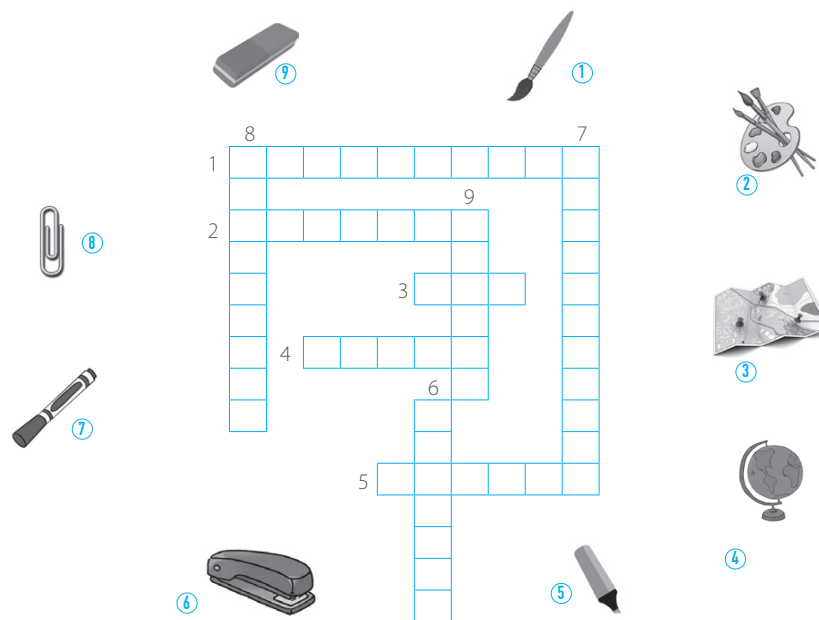

### Remember !

The verb "**be**" is a **full verb** and an **auxiliary**. It is an **irregular** verb. When it is a **full verb** it is **not followed by another verb**.

Eg.: She **is** twelve years old.  
She **is not** twelve years old.  
**Is** she twelve years old ?

| Pronouns        | Affirmative form | Negative form           | Interrogative form    |
|-----------------|------------------|-------------------------|-----------------------|
| I               | am / 'm          | am not / 'm not         | am I ?                |
| you / we / they | are / 're        | are not / 're not       | are you / we / they ? |
| he / she / it   | is / 's          | is not / 's not / isn't | is he / she / it ?    |
