Adjectives / Present simple

Remember !

- 1. The present simple tense is the **base form** of the verb but with the third person singular (she/he/it), we add an "-s". **Eg.: live** in Algeria./He **lives** in Algeria.
- 2. To form questions in the present simple we use "do" for "I/you/we/they" and "does" for her/he/it. Eg.: Do you have any money?/Does he have any money?
